A beaver recounts his experiences as an actor pursuing his dream to be in the movies.

In the ever-increasingly racially inclusive motion picture industry, an actor fights for representation as one of the least represented minority groups in Hollywood - the North American Beaver (*Castor Canadensis*).

Part light-hearted documentary-style film about an animated beaver following his dream to be in the movies, part metaphorical tale of the director's experiences in the animation industry, "Nubbinwood" is the untold story of a unfortunate "artist" who refuses to stop dreaming.

SYNOPSIS

Nubbinwood is an actor, and beaver, who dreams of being in the movies.

Unfortunately, Hollywood doesn't make movies starring beavers; so, for over 20 years he has been auditioning for a wide variety of non-beaver acting roles.

Listen as he shares his personal struggles as one of the least represented minority groups in Hollywood (North American Beaver), as well as his archival recordings from some of the most iconic animated-character auditions from his acting career. Being the only beaver actor in Hollywood has never been easy.

ABOUT THE WRITER / DIRECTOR / ANIMATOR

Tim Granberg moved to Los Angeles in 2000 with a story idea for a short film about a resourceful beaver. Over the next 10 years he would teach himself animation, work at several animation studios and develop his short film idea into a feature-length movie script. However, a script is nothing without a star, and that's when Nubbinwood was born.

The short film that was to follow, "Nubbinwood," has little in common with the original story idea. Instead, it is the story of an aspiring actor, and his experiences as he tries to get his first professional acting job. In many ways Nubbinwood's successes and failures as an actor parallels Tim's own life experiences as an animator. Today, Nubbinwood's dream of appearing in a movie and Tim's dream of making his feature film are closely linked with "Nubbinwood" representing just another step in both of them pursuing their dreams.
